3-4 Classes Per Week | 40 Weeks | Full Time
2 Classes Per Week | 80 Weeks | Part Time

COURSE DELIVERY

This course is delivered via face-to-face teaching, demonstration, and practical application. Students experience a simulated workplace environment, with access to equipment, products and facilities reflecting industry practice. Students are also required to complete a total of 100 hours of work.

STUDENT CLINIC

SCA operates a student run clinic day designed to enable students to gain valuable experience and skills for treating clients in a beauty salon environment. Students are supervised by an educator and perform treatments in which they have been deemed competent in.
